DAY 1 WED, NOV 05



Upon arrival at Ben Gurion Airport, you'll be met by your guide and begin your journey with a visit to the ancient city of Jaffa—a place rich with Biblical heritage and prophetic meaning. It's a fitting place to start as we set our hearts on the spiritual significance of this land.

We'll then visit Kikar HaChatufim (Hostage Square), a place that has become a national symbol of grief, hope, and unity. Here, we will pause to honour the hostages and stand in prayerful solidarity with their families and all who suffer in this ongoing conflict.

From there, we'll make our way to Jerusalem, stopping at Mount Scopus for a stunning view of the Holy City. After check-in and some rest, we'll share dinner together at the hotel—reflecting on all we've seen and preparing our hearts for the days ahead.

DAY 2

THU, NOV 06



After breakfast, we head south toward the Gaza border to visit a Kibbutz impacted by the October 7th attacks. Here, we'll listen to local stories of grief and courage, standing in quiet solidarity with those who've endured unimaginable loss.

At the Nova Festival site and Car Graveyard, we'll reflect and pray. Returning to Jerusalem, we'll meet with MADA to hear how they responded in crisis. Dinner and overnight at our hotel.

DAY 3

FRI, NOV 07



This morning we travel to Sderot, a city just minutes from Gaza, long marked by trauma and resilience. As we tour the community, we'll hear how families live under constant threat—and how they continue to hope.

After lunch, we return to Jerusalem in time to welcome Shabbat at the Western Wall. Joining Jewish worshippers in song and prayer, we'll honour God's presence and peace over this land. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

SAT, NOV 08



Today we walk where Jesus walked. Beginning on the Mount of Olives, we move through the Garden of Gethsemane, St Anne's, and the Palace of Herod (Kishle)—places that draw us into the final hours of Christ's passion.

We'll reflect at the Garden Tomb, then pause again at the Western Wall, standing with Israel in prayer. It's a day of deep spiritual encounter. Return to the hotel for dinner and rest.

DAY 5

SUN, NOV 09



This morning we visit Hadassah Hospital on Mount Scopus, a place of healing and hope amid the scars of conflict. We'll hear how Israeli medical teams are saving lives under extreme pressure and ongoing threat.

After lunch nearby, we'll have the opportunity to donate blood with MADA—a practical act of solidarity. Back at the hotel, a guest speaker will share personal insights. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

DAY 6

MON, NOV 10



Today begins with hands-on service at the Hineni soup kitchen, where we'll help feed the hungry and bring comfort through practical care. It's a special chance to serve with love in the heart

Later, we travel to Neot Kedumim, planting trees as a sign of hope and restoration. Back at the hotel, we'll hear from another guest speaker, then share dinner and rest for the night.

TUE, NOV 11



After breakfast and check-out, we spend the morning volunteering, continuing our mission of serving and standing with the people of Israel in practical ways.

We then drive north, stopping at the ANZAC Memorial in Tsemach—a moving reminder of shared history and sacrifice. After checking in at our hotel near the Sea of Galilee, we'll enjoy dinner and rest in this peaceful, sacred setting.

Later, we'll gather for a time of prayer on Mount Hippos (Sussita), overlooking the Sea of Galilee—a place to reflect on being a light in dark times. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

THU, NOV 13



After breakfast, we'll check out and begin our journey back to Ben Gurion Airport, hearts full from all we've seen, served, and shared.

Though we depart, our solidarity doesn't end here. We return home carrying the stories, prayers, and purpose of this land and its people.
